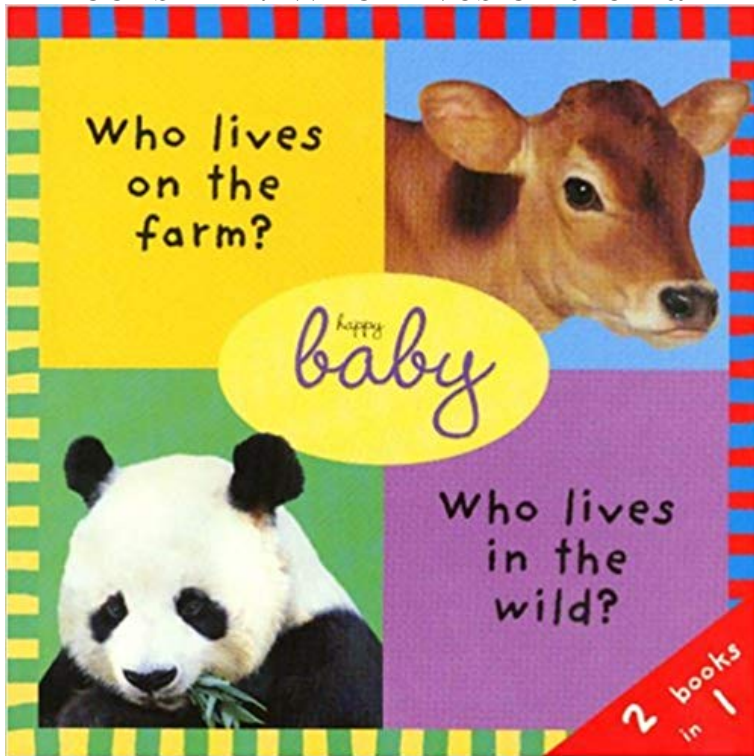


2 Books in 1: Who Lives on the Farm and Who Lives in the Wild?
