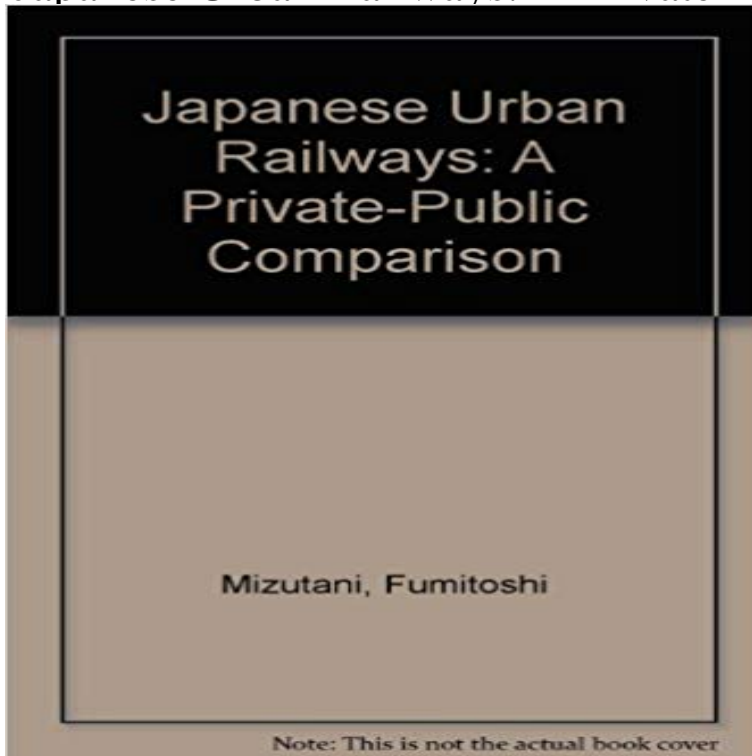


Japanese Urban Railways: A Private-Public Comparison
