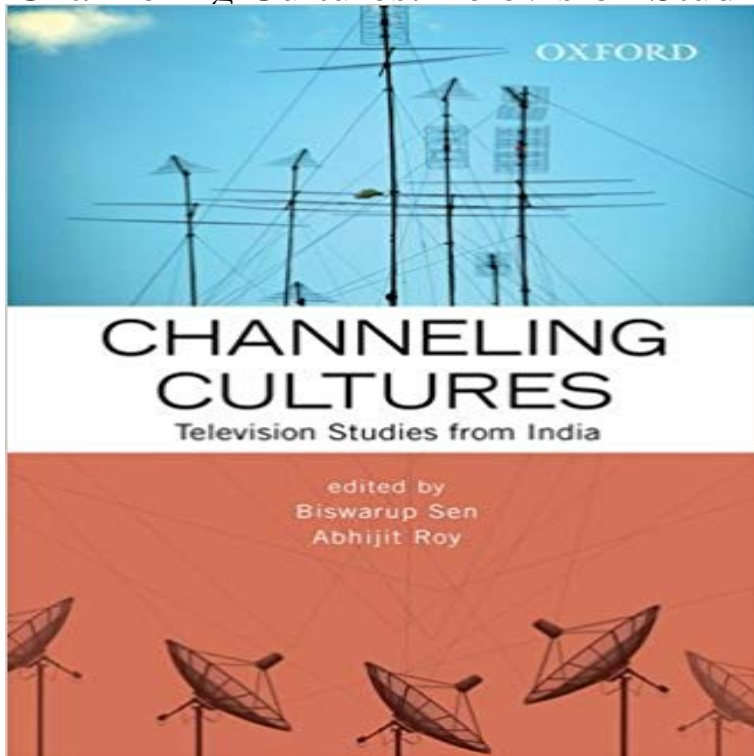


Channeling Cultures: Television Studies from India
