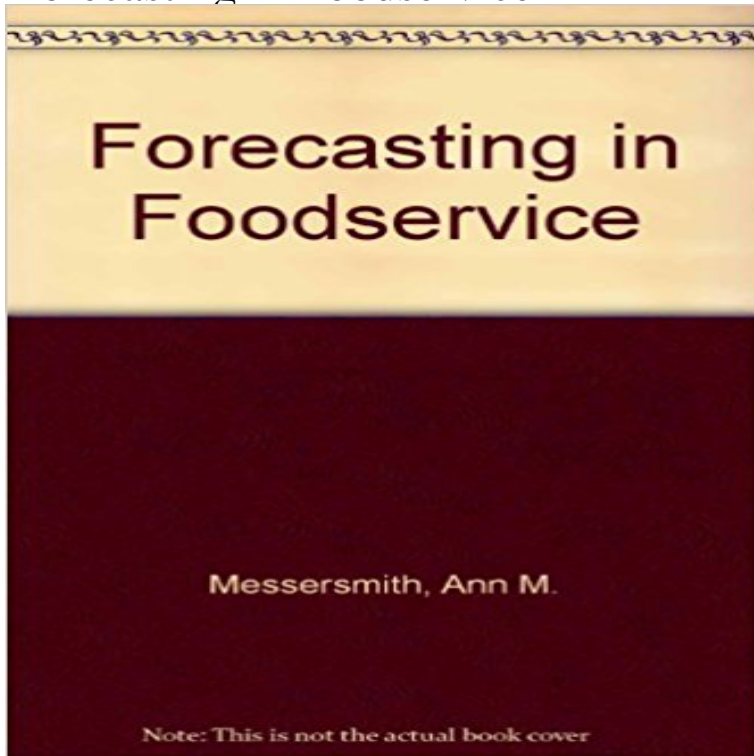


## Forecasting in Foodservice
