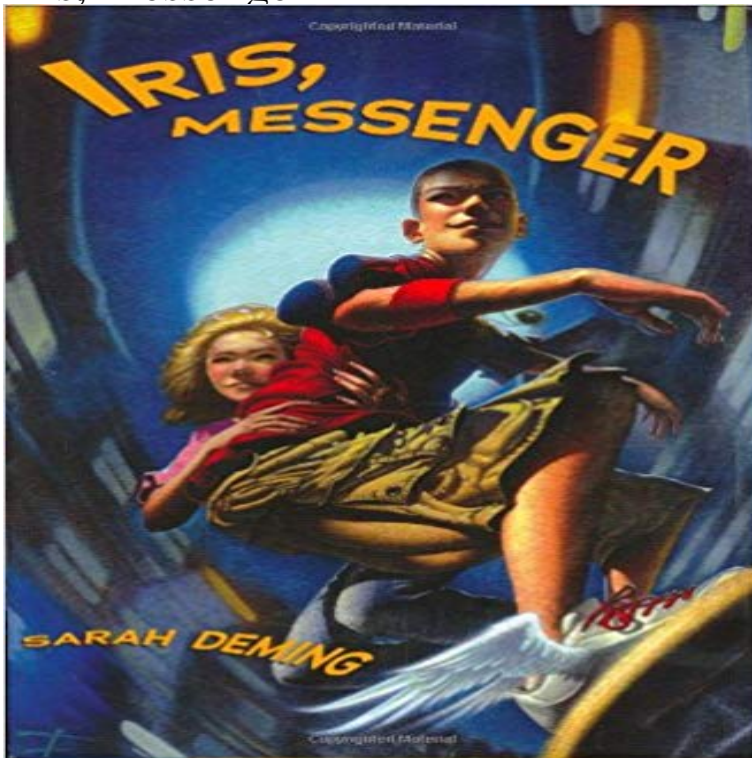


Iris, Messenger
