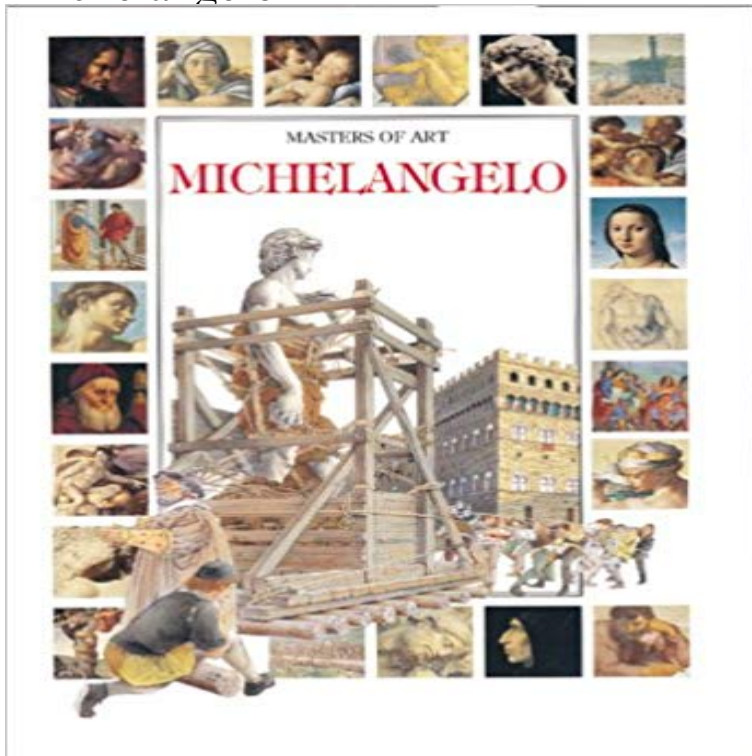


Michelangelo
