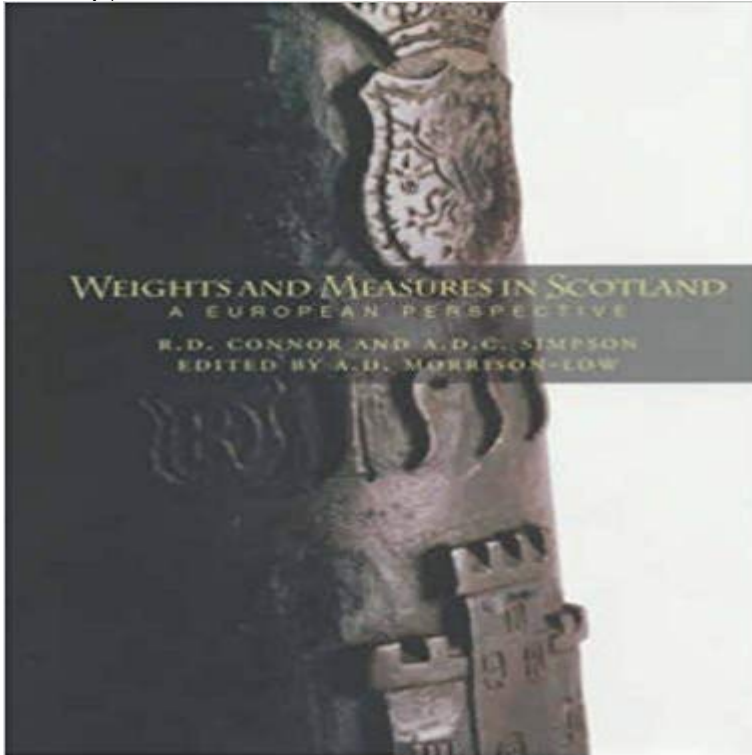


Weights and Measures of Scotland: A European Perspective
