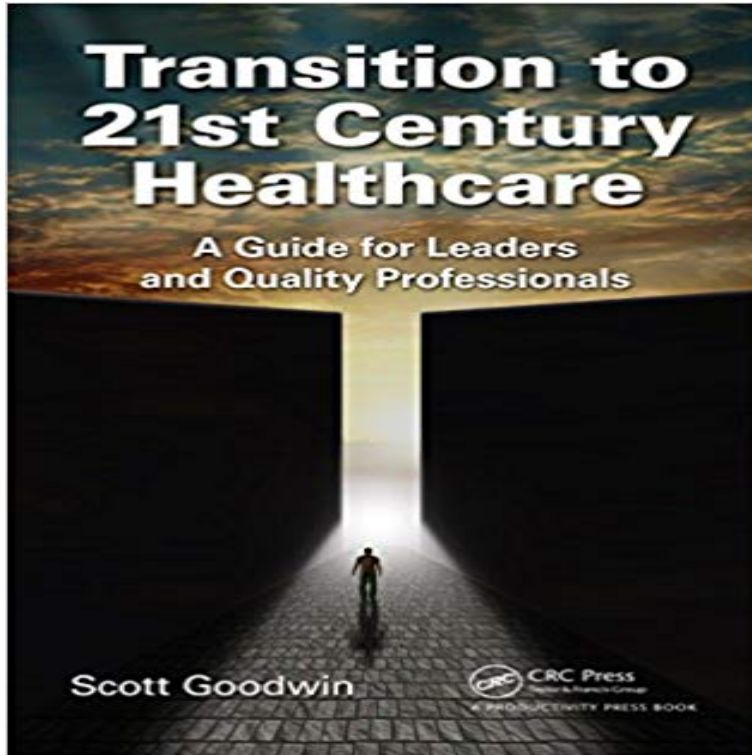


# Transition to 21st Century Healthcare: A Guide for Leaders and Quality Professionals
