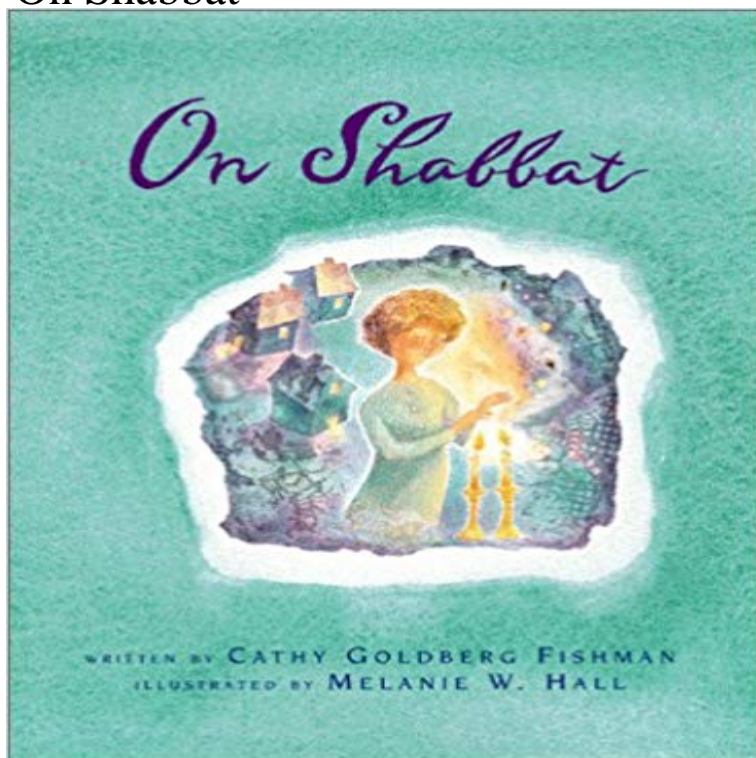


On Shabbat
