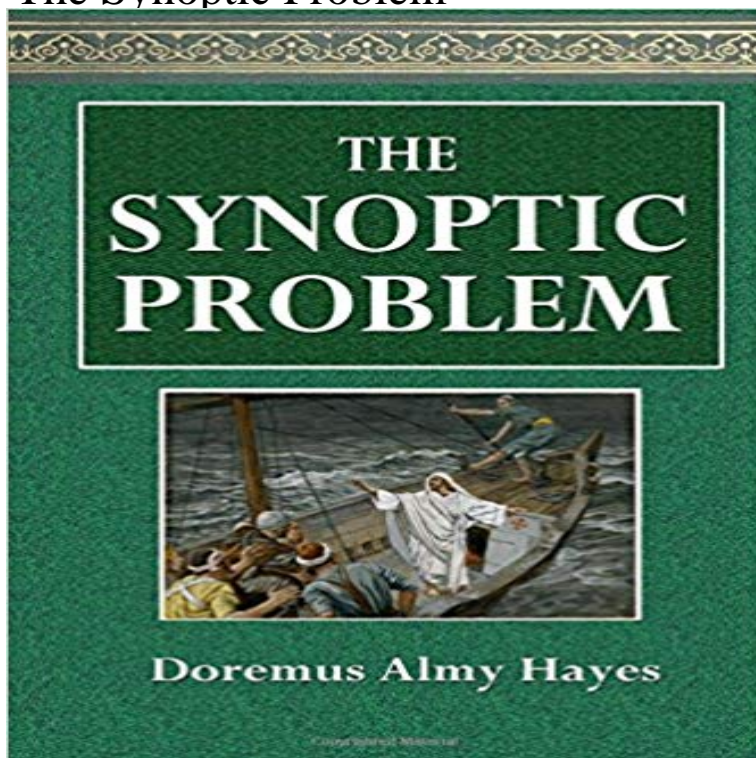


## The Synoptic Problem
