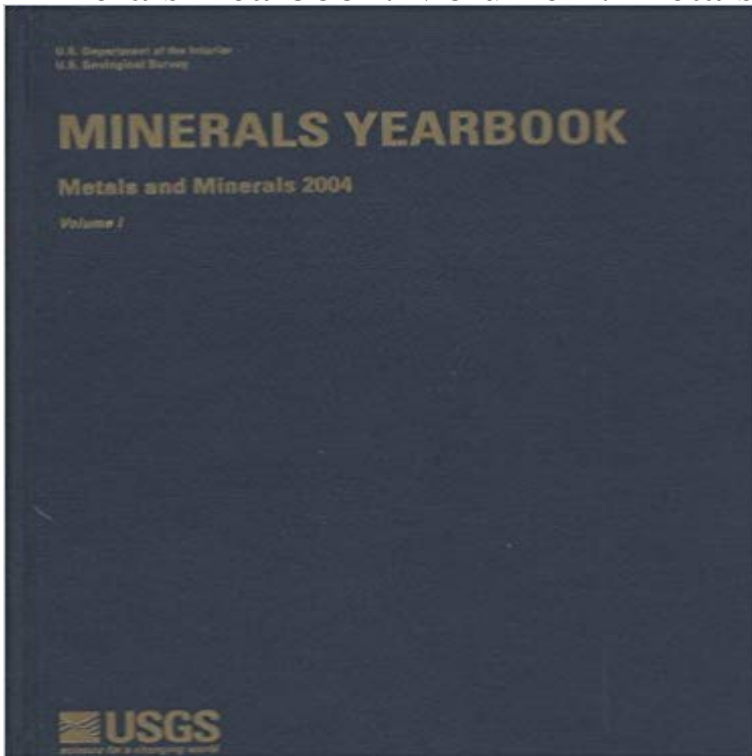


Minerals Yearbook: Volume 1: Metals and Minerals 2004

Background information enables analysis of the data, and covers production, consumption, prices, foreign trade, a world review, and an overall outlook.
